

5% yard	Planets-Glow in the Dark - Black (F)	9031G-99
5% yard	Spaceships-Glow in the Dark - Black (G)	9027G-99
1 yard	Diodes - Blue (H)	9032-77
1 yard	Diodes - Red (I)	9032-88
⅓ yard	Diodes - Black (J)	9032-99
⅓ yard	Star Chart-Glow in the Dark - Black (K)	9029G-99

Cutting Instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Solar Chart-Glow in the Dark - Black (A), fussy cut:

• (1) 34 ½" x 40 ½" panel.

From the Tossed Postcards - Black (B), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x 34 ½" WOF strips.

From the Starlet - Yellow (C), cut:

- (5) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 2" x 48 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (52) 2 1/8" squares.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Postcards - Red (D), cut:

• (3) strips ½" on either side of a strip of postcards. Sew the strips together end to end and match the pattern. Cut (2) strips 48 ½" long.

From the Astronauts-Glow in the Dark - Black (E), cut:

• (2) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (7) 8 ½" squares.

From the Planets-Glow in the Dark - Black (F), cut:

• (2) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (7) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Spaceships-Glow in the Dark - Black (G), cut:

• (2) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 8 ½" squares.

From the Diodes - Blue (H), cut:

- (3) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (46) 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 %" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) 2 %" squares.

From the Diodes - Red (I), cut:

- (3) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (46) 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) 2 1/8" squares.

From the Diodes - Black (J), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 7 ½" strips.
- (2) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 8 ½" x 7 ½" strips.

From the Star Chart-Glow in the Dark - Black (K), cut:


- (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 7 ½" strips.
- (2) 7 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 8 ½" x 7 ½" strips.

From the Star Chart-Glow in the Dark - Black (Backing), cut:


• (2) 98" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 80" x 98" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the 34 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric A panel to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1).



2. Sew (1) 2" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Fabric D 48 ½" strip. Trim the strip to measure 7 ½" x 48 ½" to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.






3. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of the Unit 1 block to make the Center Block (Fig. 3).

- 4. Place (1) 2 1/8" Fabric C square on top of (1) 2 1/8" Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 4). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 5) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure 2 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 3 blocks (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (52) Unit 3 blocks total.
- 5. Repeat Step 4 using (26) 2 %" Fabric C squares and (26) 2 %" Fabric I squares to make (52) 2 ½" Unit 4 blocks (Fig. 7).




6. Sew (1) Unit 3 block to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric H strip to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 8). Pay attention to the orientation of the blocks. Repeat to make (26) Unit 5 strips total.



7. Sew (1) Unit 4 block to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric I strip to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 9). Pay attention to the orientation of the blocks. Repeat to make (26) Unit 6 strips total.




- 8. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of (1) 8 ½" Fabric E square. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.
- 9. Repeat Step 8 and use Figures 11 through 15 for fabric identification and location to make the designated number of blocks. There will (20) blocks total.



- 10. Sew (3) Unit 5 strips and (3) Unit 6 strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 16 below). Repeat to make a second Unit 7 strip.
- 11. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of (1) 7 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric K strip to make (1) Unit 8 block (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (6) Unit 8 blocks total.
- 12. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of (1) 7 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric J strip to make (1) Unit 9 block (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (6) Unit 8 blocks total.




13. Sew (3) Unit 8 blocks and (3) Unit 9 blocks together, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 19). Repeat to make a second Unit 10 strip.


Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 14. Sew (1) Block Five square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six square and (1) Block Two square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the left side of the Center Block.
- 15. Sew (1) Block One square, (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Four square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the right side of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew (1) Block One square, (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Six square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the top of the Center Block.
- 17. Sew (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Five square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six square and (1) Block Two square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 18. Sew (1) Unit 10 strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.
- 19. Sew (1) Unit 7 strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.
- 20. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 21. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 22. Bind as desired.
